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### Best Caregiver Award

#### About the Award

The Best Caregiver Award honors a caregiver who has gone above and beyond in supporting someone living with Fabry disease. This award celebrates the dedication, compassion, and personal impact of individuals who provide ongoing care and support.

The Best Caregiver Award will be announced during the **FSIG Expert Fabry Conference**.

- **First Place Award:** Plaque and a \$150 Visa/Mastercard gift card
- **Runner-Up Finalist:** Plaque and a \$75 Visa/Mastercard gift card

Nominees and/or applicants **do not need to be present** at the conference to receive the award.

#### Eligibility

- Nominees must be a **family member, significant other, or friend** who serves as a caregiver.
- Nominations may be submitted **only by individuals living with Fabry disease**.
- Awards **cannot be won by the same individual two years in a row**.

Individuals living with Fabry disease are invited to nominate a caregiver they feel truly deserves recognition. Over the years, our community has shared countless stories of extraordinary caregivers. This is your opportunity to recognize someone who has made a meaningful difference in your life.

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### **Best Medical Professional Award**

#### **About the Award**

The Best Medical Professional Award recognizes a healthcare provider who has demonstrated exceptional commitment, expertise, and compassion in the care of individuals living with Fabry disease. This award honors medical professionals who have made a lasting impact through clinical care, advocacy, education, or support.

The Best Medical Professional Award will be announced during the **FSIG Expert Fabry Conference**.

- **First Place Award:** Plaque and a \$150 Visa/Mastercard gift card
- **Runner-Up Finalist:** Plaque and a \$75 Visa/Mastercard gift card

Nominees and/or applicants **do not need to be present** at the conference to receive the award.

#### **Eligibility**

- Nominees must be a **licensed medical or healthcare professional** involved in the care of individuals with Fabry disease.
- Nominations may be submitted by **individuals living with Fabry disease or their caregivers**.
- Awards **cannot be won by the same individual two years in a row**.

Nominators are invited to recognize a medical professional who has gone above and beyond in providing care, guidance, advocacy, or support related to Fabry disease.

Please submit a **brief essay (maximum 600 words)** describing why your nominee deserves the Best Medical Professional Award. Examples may include outstanding clinical care, patient advocacy, education, or long-term dedication to the Fabry community.
